34- Hannah leads the field to the green and takes the early lead with 46-Williams trying hard on the outside. 99-Oakley and 10-Page move low and hang the 46-Williams outside. 99-Oakley goes after 34-Hannah taking the lead out of turn four. The 10-Page tries to go with him but gets loose off turn four. 99- Oakley pulls out to a comfortable lead, 34-Hannah, 46-Williams and, 10-Page, 2- Lorance round out the top five. With open race track in front of him 99-Oakley sets sail and opens up a 7-10 car length lead over second place 34-Hannah. The 46-Williams running third works on 34-Hannah for several laps trying to get the second spot. 46-Williams gets a run on 34-Hannah and brings the 10-Page, 18-Stiffler, 2-Lorance with him. 34-Hannah and 31-Fleming now battle for 6<sup>th</sup>. The racing going on mid pack was absolutely great racing!! The position switched back and forth with some real hard fought battles everywhere. 99-Oakley had everybody covered with 46-Williams in second followed by 10-Page in third, behind them it was the best racing of the year. The positions changed every lap there for awhile. The caution came out when the 28-Day was turned going into turn one. On the restart once again 99-Oakley was in control but the 46-Williams was holding his this time a few car lengths back with the 10-Page right there for third followed by 18-Stiffler, 2-Lorance,34-Hannah,31-Fleming, 4-Willingham all having a great race for the top five. Our new friends from Oklahoma had a real rough time with our dreaded turn four. As every one of us has experienced what that turn can do to you, we understand what they are going through. The 07-Johnson gets lose off turn four and spins on the front stretch. The track hesitated on the yellow hoping he could return to action on his own thinking he was low enough on the track. 99-Oakley leading one of the fastest races of the year moves low to lap the 28-Day and there was the 07-Johnson.
